Additional weeks of unemployment benefits and increase in unemployment amounts

Making Work Pay Credit

Reduction in Social Security and Medicare taxes for individuals

Increase in food stamp benefits

Source and Method for Estimating County Amounts

These benefit amounts are taken from the Department of Labor, and allocated by county in proportion to the county's share of state employment. The amounts for the extra \$25 in weekly benefits go only through July 2011.

A national figure for the credit amount through June 2011 is available from the Office of Tax analysis, and is posted on Recovery.gov.

The state amount was developed by using an estimate from the Council of Economic Advisors on the percent of the Making Work Pay credit going to each state.

County estimates were developed by allocating the credit based on each county's share of statewide employment.

A 2011 figure for Wisconsin is based on a whole-year figure for the state from the Treasury Department, which was then prorated through August 2011. County estimates were developed the same way as for the Making Work Pay credit.

The state benefit amount is taken from the weekly Recovery Act report of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. County estimates were made by assuming the benefit was distributed relative to the number of recipients in each county.

County dollar amounts are from the Social Security Administration.
